It is open to all radiographers, student radiographers and supplementary diagnostic radiographers who are registrable with the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA), and organisations and institutions with direct interest in the profession of radiography. The Society is regionally represented in all the large centres in South Africa and is a member of the International Society of Radiographers and Radiological Technologists (ISRRT).

The aims of the Society are mainly to represent radiographers and to promote reliable radiographic services in South Africa by influencing training and by promoting an advisory service for the evaluation of equipment.

The Society actively encourages continuing professional advancement of radiographers and to this end it regularly holds update seminars and national congresses, which are open to all interested persons. The Society is the only professional radiographic association in Africa, which publishes a professional journal with local, neighbouring countries and overseas circulation. Persons who wish to join the Society can obtain further information from the regional branches and/or the administrative office.
